PE Award Criterion changed for 2009

The Outstanding Flotilla PE Award criteria is changed starting in 2009 to recognize numbers of graduates (production) as well as instructor hours (effort). Graduates of short, one day classes are factored due to the great numbers these programs may graduate (over 3,000 boat and kids in 2008). Large and small flotillas are more equally recognized by factoring the total membership of each flotilla. Here is the new wording. There is no change to the instructor award.

Public Education Award.

a. **Outstanding Flotilla Trophy in Public Education.** A perpetual trophy with keeper award will be awarded. Criteria are as follows:

- (1) The Flotilla must have reported at least 52 hours of Public Education Classes during the award year.
- (2) The Flotilla must have the highest Score of all Flotillas considered. This Score will be the total of PE Hours plus the total of PE Graduate Points, divided by the flotilla Active Membership at the year end.
- (3) PE Graduate Points for each flotilla will be the sum of its graduates from classes lasting less than 8 hours times 1/15, plus the sum of all its other graduates. The factor of 1/15 is used to approximate the classroom hours for these graduates compared to graduates of other classes.
- (4) Any flotilla receiving this award for its PE program in one year will be ineligible to receive it again during the following two years

b. This award will be determined by the DSO-PE from the end-of-year AUXDATA reports.
